Recording Audio with Power Point

Open Power Point

Open Slide Show to have audio added

Slide Show – Record Narration

 Select Quality – 8kHz – 16 bit

 Set Microphone level

 Click OK

To end, right click – End Show

Save timings

Save file (use a different name from original)

Open Impatica

Add the file to be converted

Check Options

Slide Show

New Impatica file format

Apply extra compression

Target Screen dimensions – automatic

Include playback controls

Media

At end of Slide

Sound Format - compact

Set JPEG compression

Set encoding

Extra Output Files

HTML

Zip

Export notes if used

Click Impaticize

Click Done

Directions for Recording with Viewlet Cam

Open Viewlet Cam

Capturing

File – New

Select name

Browse for directory

Next

Select Capture Mode

Next

Use Select tool (if single window or area)

Select a mode automatically

Check “record sound”

Select capture rate

Finish

(ctrl alt F11 to start recording)

(ctrl alt F11 to end recording)

(ctrl alt F12 to pause or resume recording)

Save

File – Convert swf to exe
